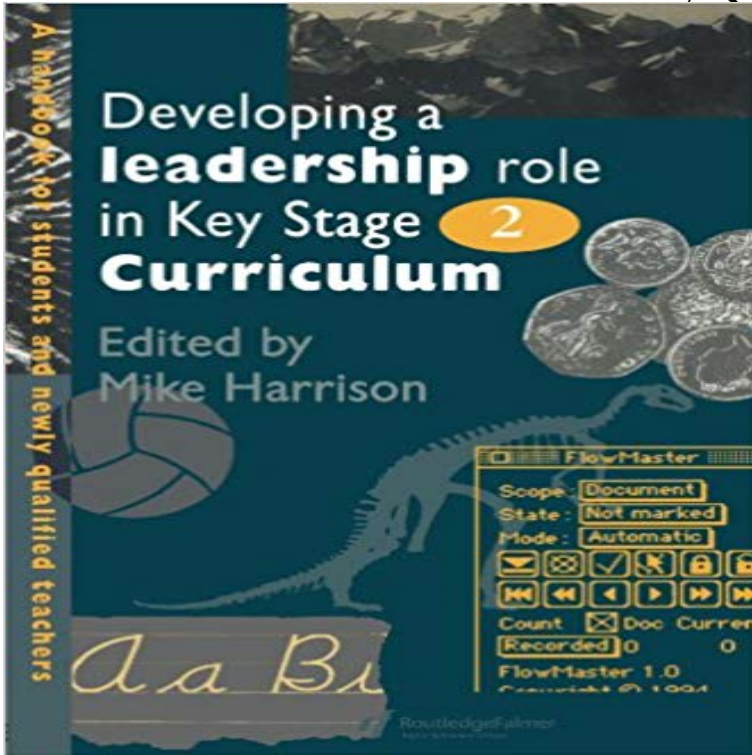


Developing A Leadership Role Within The Key Stage 2 Curriculum: A Handbook For Students And Newly Qualified Teachers
