

## Arts and Crafts of Central Asia (Discovery Central Asia, 33)



Year, 2011, Central Asian countries are marking 20 years of Independence. This has been a new Golden Era for the development of Arts and Crafts in the region. After 75 years of Soviet repression, many local crafts were given a new lease of life. Many skills had been almost lost or forgotten. For centuries, the arts and crafts of Central Asia enjoyed a well-earned fame. The pre-eminence of the applied art here can be attributed to historical conditions shaping the cultural development of Central Asian peoples, who have developed their technical and artistic traditions over centuries. This applied art reflects everyday life, its main attribute being the close connection between artistic creativity and daily material necessity. The social nature of decorative art lies in its collectivity. Art is the heritage of many generations; it represents a series of consecutive layers, which reflect a peoples culture through the ages. The skills and knowledge imparted by the various ethnic groups that eventually came together to constitute Central Asian peoples created this diversity of artistic traditions that is the distinguishing feature in works of art of all genres. In this issue we tried to collect just a few samples of the rich and unique variety of arts and crafts of Central Asia. Some of them are already well-known, but you may find several which will be surprising and new for you.
