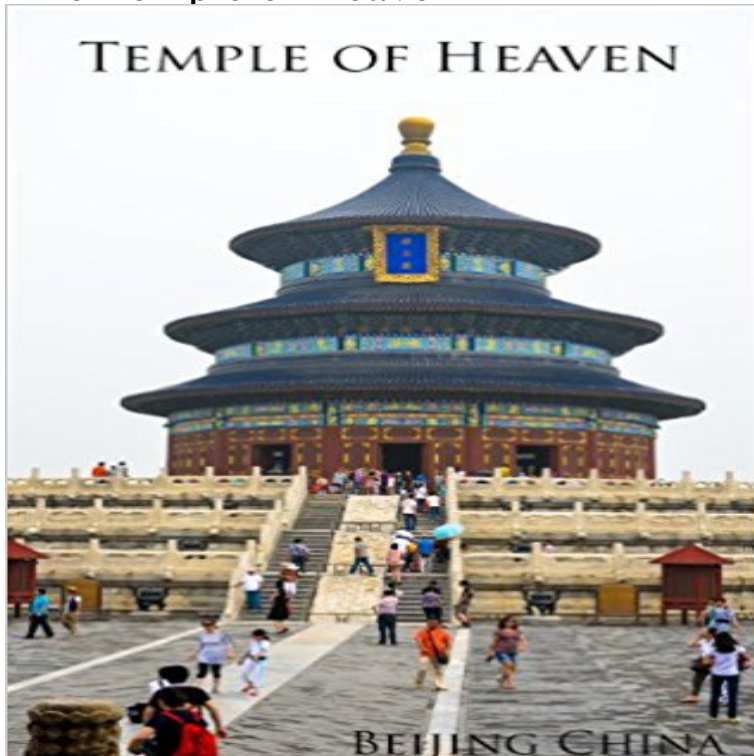


The Temple of Heaven
