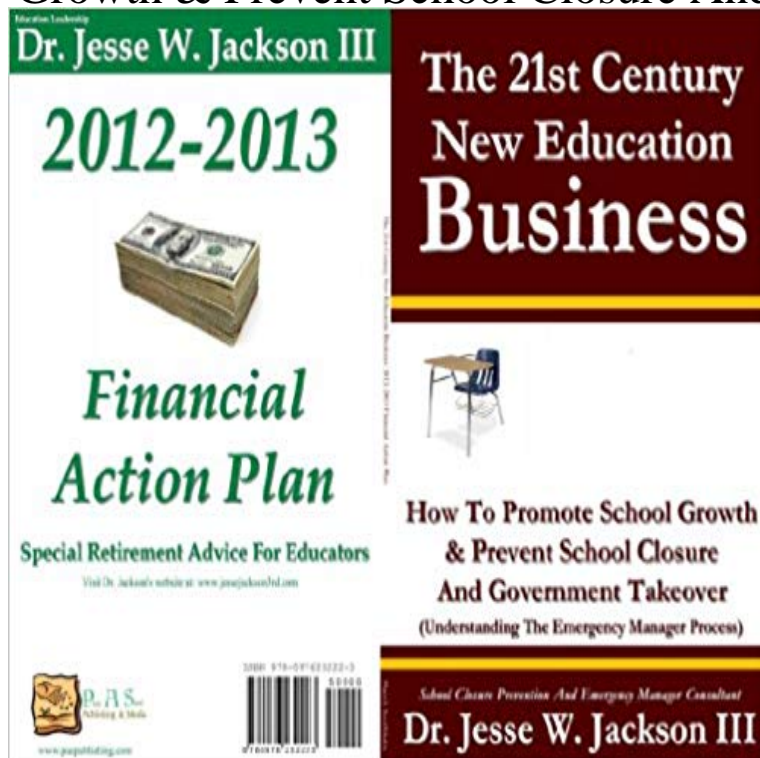


The 21st Century New Education Business: How To Promote School Growth & Prevent School Closure And Government Takeover

The goal is to balance the budget, but oftentimes the emergency manager wants to take over every phase of the operation which includes academics. This is often where this process gets very interesting. Unfortunately, in thousands of school districts are in need of an emergency manager. However, if you are a leader in a school district and you wish to grow your school and avoid this process; there ten action principles you must adhere to. I have had some of my clients adopt these things immediately and correct their situation. I have seen others who are too committed to their failing ways refuse to change and the district was taken over by the state. That meant everyone got laid off and less than 20% to 60% of the entire district staff were called back. Dont let this be you. If you are serious about correcting the problems in your district, these ten action principles will be extremely valuable to you and your staff.

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
