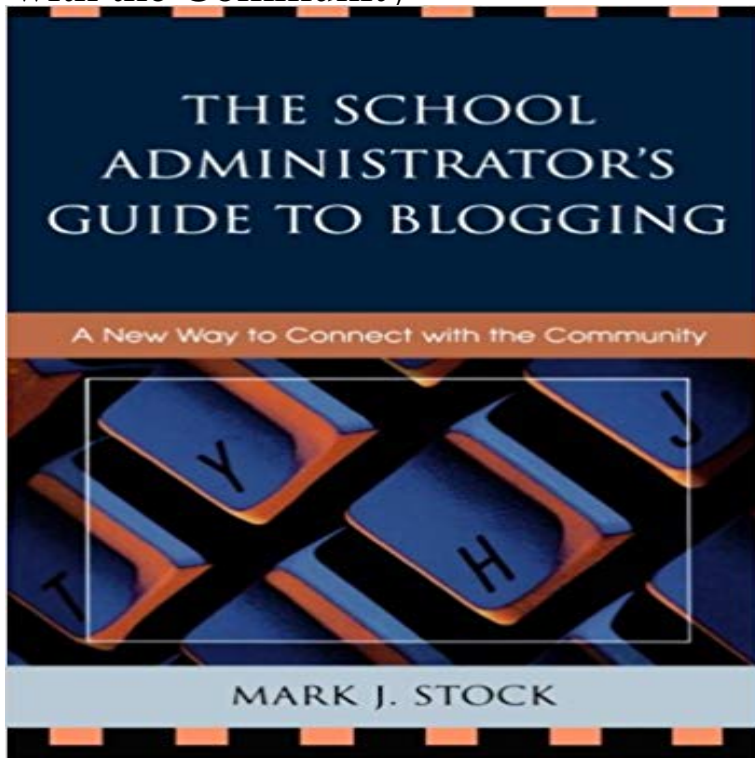


The School Administrators Guide to Blogging: A New Way to Connect with the Community
